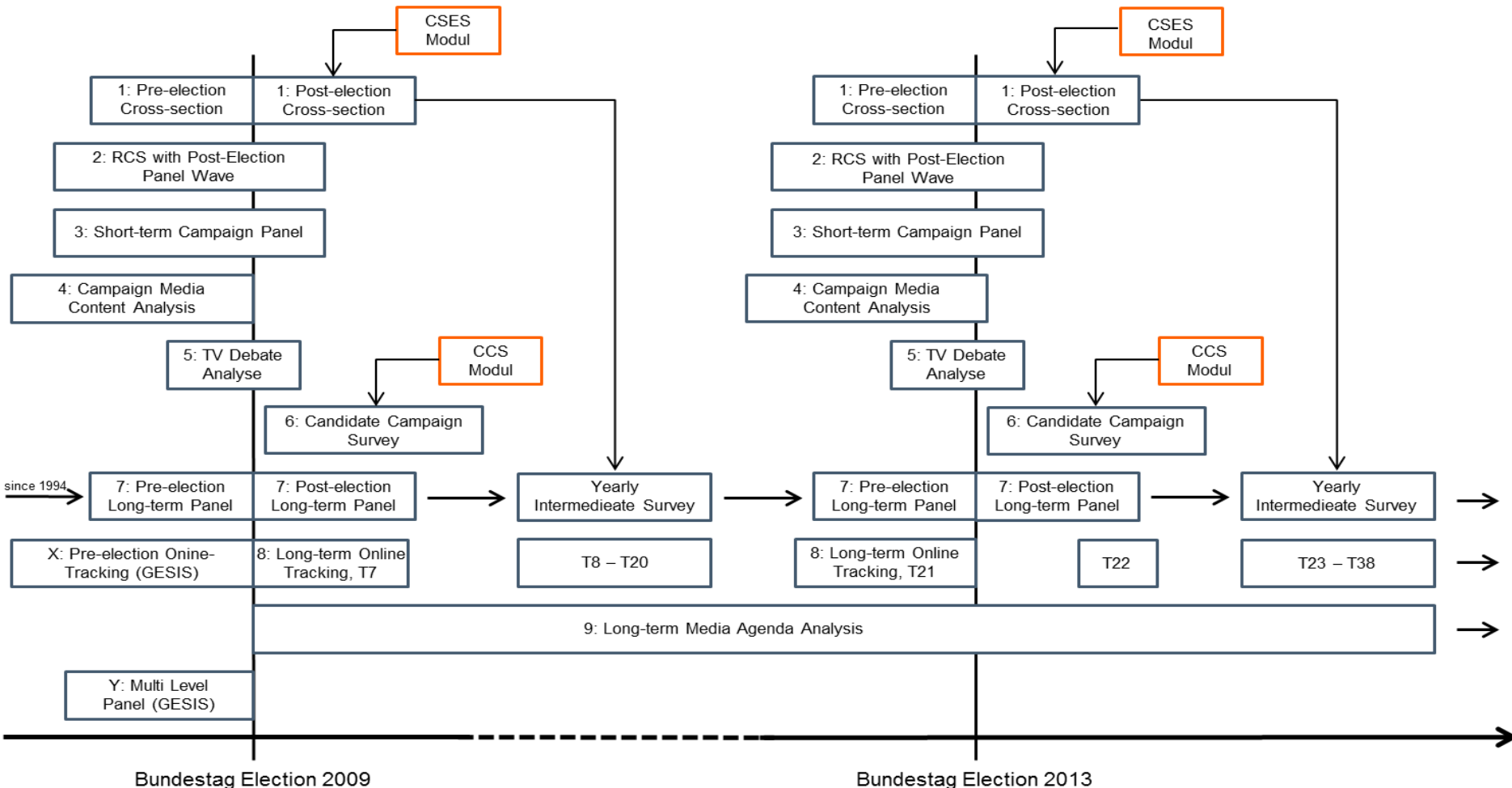

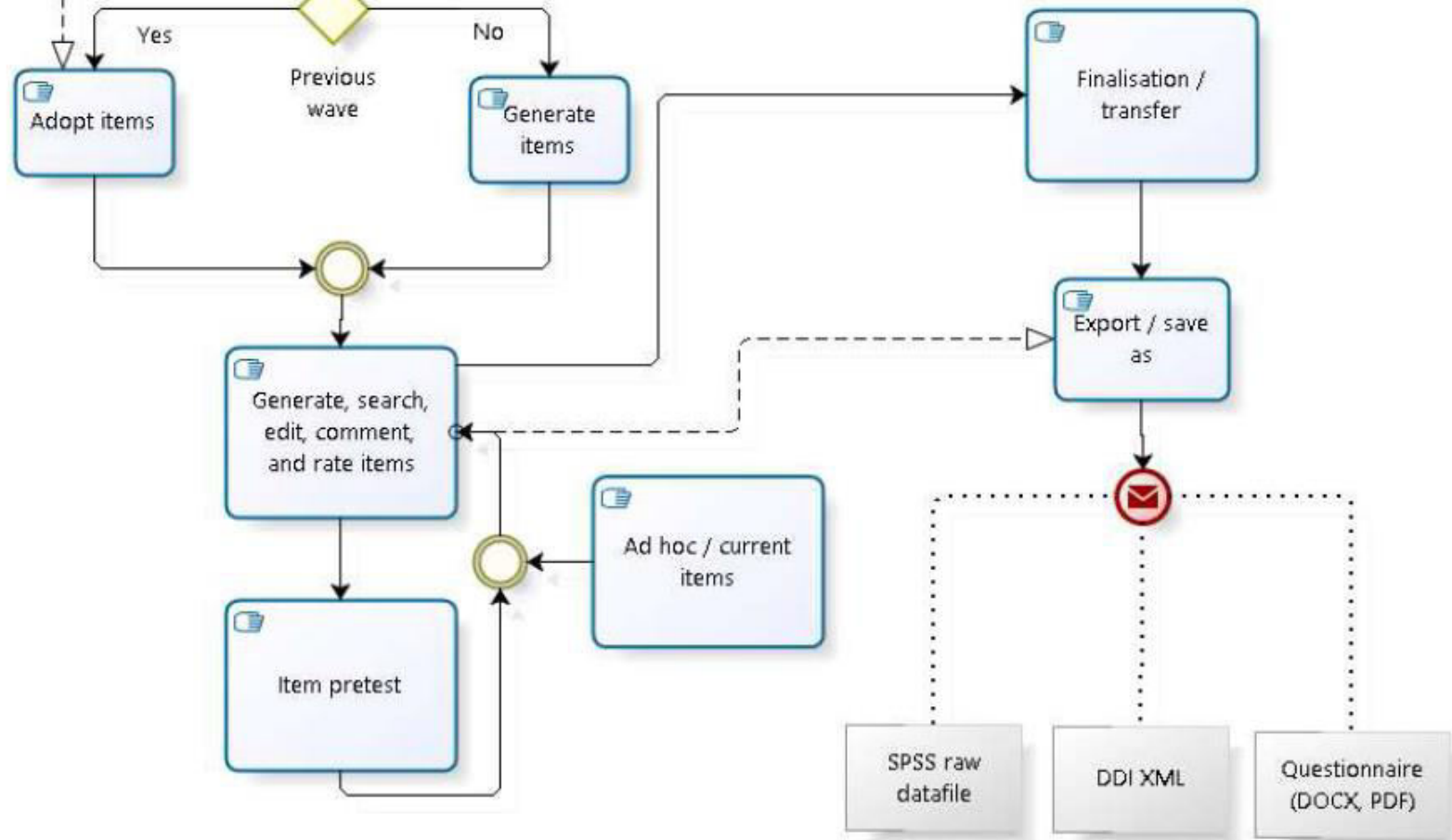


One portal for the whole study lifecycle

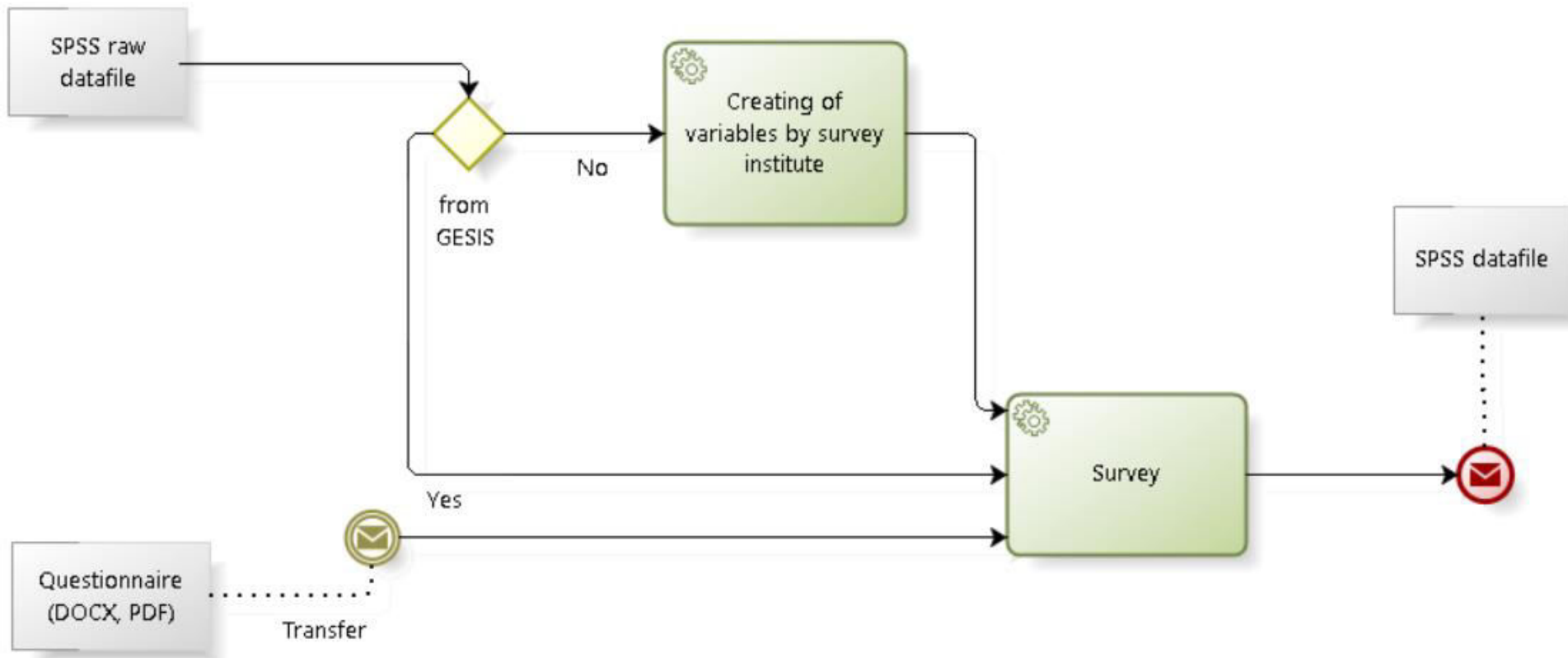
Functions

- Standardization of operational procedure with DDI

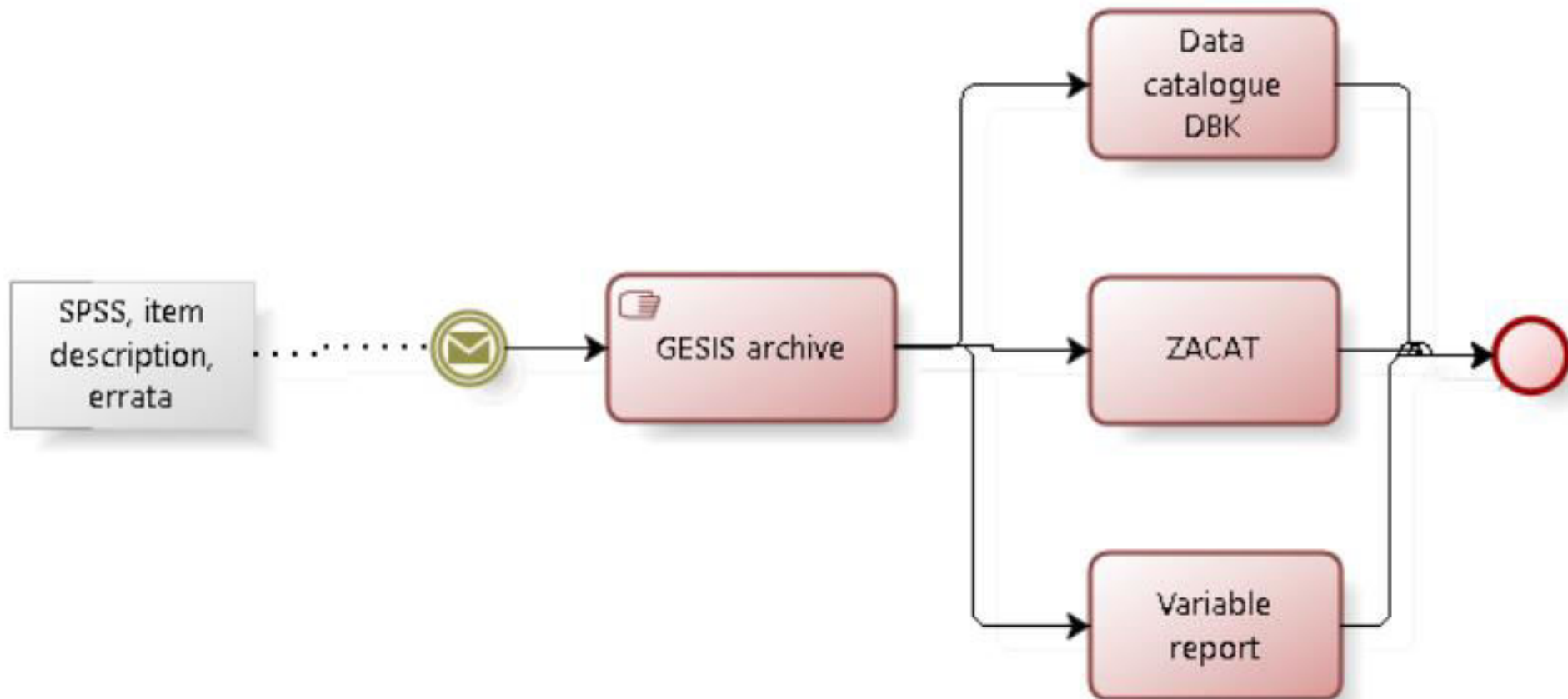
