About SND

SND is an initiative of the Swedish research council, it is situated at University of Gothenburg and financed jointly by the research council and the university

SND focuses on:

- Data collection and dissemination
- Data protection, documentation and availability
- The development of standards and tools used for documentation and making data available
- Legal and ethical aspects when databases are established and also in the management of data and its availability
- Support and guidance during the research process
- Participation in and support for the establishment of competence within secondary analysis of the data

Study level documentation

SIMS – SND's Internal Management System

- In-house developed system
- DDI based (combination of versions 2 and 3)
- Exports and imports DDI 2, Exports parts of DDI 3
- Contains documentation of study and variable level elements, other materials, publications, projects, series, contacts, organisations, disseminations and more
- Drawback. Can't import metadata from SPSS



Some info about eXist


- Open source database management system built using XML technology.
- Stores XML data according to the XML data model.
- Features efficient, index-based XQuery processing.
- Easy to access using wsdl
- Good base for building web services







Metadata flow within SND – Future plans










XSLT Stylesheets for creation of codebooks
